## MONTHLY BIBLE MEMORIZATION

**Genesis 1:1-3** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. <sup>2</sup> And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. <sup>3</sup> And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

**Genesis 1:31-2:3** <sup>31</sup> And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, *it was* very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day. <sup>1</sup> Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. <sup>2</sup> And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. <sup>3</sup> And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

**Psalms 8:1-9** (To the chief Musician upon Gittith, A Psalm of David.) O LORD our Lord, how excellent *is* thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens. <sup>2</sup> Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest still the enemy and the avenger. <sup>3</sup> When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; <sup>4</sup> What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him? <sup>5</sup> For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. <sup>6</sup> Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all *things* under his feet: <sup>7</sup> All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field; <sup>8</sup> The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, *and whatsoever* passeth through the paths of the seas. <sup>9</sup> O LORD our Lord, how excellent *is* thy name in all the earth!

**Job 38:1-7** Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said, <sup>2</sup> Who *is* this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge? <sup>3</sup> Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou me. <sup>4</sup> Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding. <sup>5</sup> Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it? <sup>6</sup> Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof; <sup>7</sup> When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?
