Genesis 2:16-17 <sup>16</sup> And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: <sup>17</sup> But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Leviticus 26:12 And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be my people.

**Deuteronomy 11:26-28** <sup>26</sup> Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; <sup>27</sup> A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day: <sup>28</sup> And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

**Hosea 6:1-7** <sup>1</sup> Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up. <sup>2</sup> After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight. <sup>3</sup> Then shall we know, *if* we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter *and* former rain unto the earth. <sup>4</sup> O Ephraim, what shall I do unto thee? O Judah, what shall I do unto thee? for your goodness *is* as a morning cloud, and as the early dew it goeth away. <sup>5</sup> Therefore have I hewed *them* by the prophets; I have slain them by the words of my mouth: and thy judgments *are as* the light *that* goeth forth. <sup>6</sup> For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings. <sup>7</sup> But they like men have transgressed the covenant: there have they dealt treacherously against me.
