- V. Paul's Third Missionary Journey: Galatia and Phrygia, Ephesus, Macedonia, Greece (Achaia), Macedonia, Philippi, and Troas, Assos, Mitylene; near Chios, Samos, (Trogyllium), Miletus, Cos, Rhodes, Patara, Tyre and Ptolemais, Caesarea, Jerusalem.
- VI. Paul's Journey to Rome: Jerusalem, Antipatris and Caesarea, Sidon, Myra, Cnidus, Fair Havens (Crete), Clauda (Cauda), Malta (Melita), Syracuse, Rhegium, Puteoli, Appii Forum and Three Taverns, Rome.
