## MONTHLY BIBLE MEMORIZATION

**John 1:1-5** <sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> The same was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. <sup>4</sup> In him was life; and the life was the light of men. <sup>5</sup> And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

**Proverbs 1:7-8** <sup>7</sup> The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and instruction. <sup>8</sup> My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

**Proverbs 14:12** There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof *are* the ways of death.

**Proverbs 18:24** A man *that hath* friends must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend *that* sticketh closer than a brother.

**Proverbs 22:1** A *good* name *is* rather to be chosen than great riches, *and* loving favour rather than silver and gold.

**Proverbs 23:23** Buy the truth, and sell *it* not; *also* wisdom, and instruction, and understanding.

**Psalms 14:1** (To the chief Musician, A *Psalms* of David.) The fool hath said in his heart, *There is* no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, *there is* none that doeth good.

**Ecclesiastes 12:1-14** Remember now thy Creator in the days of thy youth, while the evil days come not, nor the years draw nigh, when thou shalt say, I have no pleasure in them<sup>13</sup> Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this *is* the whole *duty* of man. <sup>14</sup> For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether *it be* good, or whether *it be* evil.

**Psalms 119:9-16** BETH. Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed *thereto* according to thy word. <sup>10</sup> With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments. <sup>11</sup> Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. <sup>12</sup> Blessed *art* thou, O LORD: teach me thy statutes. <sup>13</sup> With my lips have I declared all the judgments of thy mouth. <sup>14</sup> I have rejoiced in the way of thy testimonies, as *much as* in all riches. <sup>15</sup> I will meditate in thy precepts, and have respect unto thy ways. <sup>16</sup> I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.
